### How do I study for this accreditation?

**Step 1** – Start attending the Every Child Counts training and teaching lessons in your school.

**Step 2** – Start keeping records of your Every Child Counts work. Start making notes at the training, during your lessons and at any meetings about the programme that you go to in school.

**Step 3** – As soon as you can, go online for more information and then register.

**Step 4** – Enjoy learning, discussing and sharing ideas with your fellow students and your tutors online.

**Step 5** – Write a short piece (about 2,500 words) about your work and assemble a portfolio of documents from your Every Child Counts teaching. *Your tutors will guide and support you with this every step of the way.*

### What can I use these credits for?

- In discussions with your manager about your Professional Development, they show you are continuing to learn.
- In your CV if you are applying for a new job.
- You may be able to use your credits towards further study at degree level.

### How much does it cost?

### Who would help me?

As soon as you are registered you will be contacted by an Edge Hill tutor. You will get online access to guidance and support and to discussions with tutors and fellow Every Child Counts practitioners from across the country. You will be able to get resources from the Edge Hill library either online or by postal loan, free of charge.

Don't worry if you have not worked in this way before. Our experienced tutors will help you.

### How long does it take?

You will join your fellow students for online tasks and discussions for half a term. After this you can work at your own pace, you can take up to 12 months to hand in your final written work.
